Introduction

In January, 1888, three old pioneers of the 1849 California Gold Rush, George W. Suttenfield, B. B. Harris, and Sydney P. Waite, inserted a notice in the *Chronical* asking all pioneers interested in forming a society to preserve the history of California, especially that of San Bernardino County, to be present at the city's court house on Saturday, January 21. Thirty pioneers joined the San Bernardino Society of California Pioneers that day as charter members and others were added in the years that followed.
